The house was built in 1907 by the architect Alexander Vanags. In 2018 the building was completely renovated, all communications were replaced, a new elevator was installed, the historic facade was restored. In total, there are 9 apartments in the building.

The apartment is offered with full finishing and fully furnished, during interior decoration were used finishing materials of the highest quality. Central heating, ceiling height 3.30 m. There is a spacious entrance hall, living room with kitchen, master bedroom with the dressing room, second bedroom and two bathrooms. The apartment is rented for long-term. ROI is more than 7%.

In walking distance, there is all the necessary infrastructure of the city. Gourmet restaurants, cafes, boutiques and shopping centers, museums, and fitness centers. 5-10 minutes walk till the Old Town, Vermanes Park, the embankment, as well as international railway and bus stations, suburban railway station with trains to Jurmala, which will take you there in 20 minutes.
